






ELENA MATEI INTERVIEW

1. What genres did you listen to when you were growing up? How do you think your environment shaped the music you make now?

I grew up with pop, jazz, and operatic pop. Yes, my environment definitely shaped the music I make now.

- 13. What do you want your fans to know? Any messages for your supporters?


I'm working hard on new music and soon I hope to have a live concert in NY.

remember.








